## **Resolution of the general meeting.**

As part of the decision of the general assembly of the humanitarian organization Children's Freedom for Future dated November 11, 2023, relating to the assistance program for injured children in the Gaza Strip following the armed conflict, the general meeting decides as follows:

- mandate that Mr. Mario Castonguay (founder of the organization) and Mr. Kim Tsoj (vice-president) will travel to Egypt on the border with Israel to visit the Gaza Strip;
- Mr. Castonguay and Tsoj will have to contact representatives of international organizations such as the UN, UNICEF, Doctors Without Borders, the International Red Cross and other organizations to unite common efforts in favor of children Palestinians from Gaza;
- one of our representatives can go directly to the Gaza Strip to visit hospitals, schools and other institutions in order to assess the real situation of the living conditions not only of the Palestinian population, but also of the children themselves- themselves and, above all, injured children;
- unfortunately, the only checkpoint between Egypt and Israel, Rafah, is blocked, our representatives can organize, if possible, the transport of small quantities of medicines from Egypt to hospitals in Gaza to improve the condition of injured Palestinian children;
- if it is possible to confirm a verbal offer from the Hamas organization to exchange foreign hostages for an obligation from the countries where these hostages come from to take injured Palestinian children to these countries for treatment, our organization will have to organize legal and logistical work to implement this plan. Establish joint work with other organizations to implement this humanitarian rescue operation;
- our representatives in Gaza, Mr. Mario and Mr. Kim, must account for the work accomplished every day, we must not forget the increased danger of this humanitarian mission in the Gaza Strip.

The main result of our humanitarian work should be the protection of the rights, health and lives of Palestinian children in armed conflicts, if possible, without taking a political position or politically evaluating this conflict, which corresponds to one of the most important principles of our organization - total apolitical.
